1. Call to Order and Welcome

Chris Spear, President called the Zoom meeting to order at 10:07 a.m. and welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. Approval of Agenda

It was Moved by Paul Lang and Seconded by Angéle McCaie that the agenda for the Special MAC Board Meeting of December 2, 2022 be approved. **Motion Carried.**

6. New Business

(a) Membership Criteria – Discussion of By-Law Amendment

President Chris Spear advised that the Executive Director of the AMANB has recently inquired about joining as a member of the Municipal Advisory Corporation.



Paul Lang advised that he would not be part of the decision-making process as he was in conflict of interest – Isabelle Theriault is his cousin. His concern was whether this would open up other associations that may want to be a competitor and what would the justification be to accept employees of AMANB and not other associations. Would MAC be willing to sign a contract with a non-competing clause?

Discussions centred around of what membership, means. Currently the MAC By-law states that "Non-municipal government entities must be a controlled entity by definition of the PSAB (Public Sector Accounting Board Standards..."

After a lengthy Board discussion it was the consensus of the Board that the Executive Director and employees of the AMANB would be accepted as a member of the Municipal Advisory Committee as of January 1, 2023 and that the by-law be amended to reflect the same.

Moved by Angéle McCaie, seconded by Natalie Bowen, THAT Article 3 in the Municipal Advisory Corporations By-laws be amended to include employee/s of the Association of Municipal Administrators of New Brunswick. Further that a "non-competition clause" be added to Section 3 for clarification. **Motion Carried**

8. Adjournment

It was moved by Suzanne Coulombe that the meeting of the MAC Board be adjourned. **Motion Carried**
